Important Information

- Classes in this brochure are taught by Fabrications instructor Janet Dapson.
- You must speak directly to the class instructor to register for a U-Pick class. Due to high demand, plan to schedule a class at least 4 weeks in advance of your desired time frame.
- For pre-scheduled classes, registration is required at least one week before class.
- Payment for any class must be made at the time of registration. Refunds will not be given for missed classes. Make-up classes may be available at the rate of \$20.00 per hour.
- Cancellation policy for registrants requires 24 hours notice. Because of preparation time and expenses incurred, 80% of the registration fee is refundable.
- Should a class be cancelled by Fabrications, money will be completely refunded.
- Be aware that there may be homework with some of the classes. To get the most out of these classes, you must be able to complete the assigned homework.
- Some classes are offered only as *U-Pick* (by appointment); others are scheduled for specific dates and times, but are also available as *U-Pick*. There is no minimum enrollment; we will do the class just for you. However, it is more fun and instructive when several people work together, so try to enroll a friend.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis, both for scheduled and *U-Pick* classes. Maximum enrollment is 5 students.

Sewing Machine Basics
